

**ROTORUA INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL
BOARD OF TRUSTEES POLICY**

FOOD AND CANTEEN



Rationale:

The Rotorua Intermediate School Board of Trustees support good eating habits and believe they are important to students' present and future health.

Guidelines:

1. The Board will engage a contractor to operate the school Canteen. This operator will be required to:
 - provide healthy food at a reasonable cost;
 - provide a variety of nutritious and well presented food and drinks at a reasonable cost; and
2. Handle, prepare, and serve food in a clean, hygienic and healthy environment, meeting all Food and Hygiene Standards. The Principal will be responsible for ensuring the canteen is operated in accordance with the agreement with the contractor and this policy.
3. The consumption of high fat, high sugar and other unhealthy foods by students is discouraged.
4. Students are discouraged from bringing onto school grounds during school hours high fat, high sugar drinks and sweets.
5. Students will receive information on the principles of good nutrition through the Pathway Programme.

Conclusion:

Good nutrition is to be promoted and encouraged. The School will have a set of management procedures that will facilitate compliance with legislation and regulations.

Effectiveness Review:
